Morrisville Pre-K Counts centers offer

- PA Keystone STARS level 4
- FREE youth membership for all students enrolled in our year-round programs.
- State Licensed
- Certified Teachers, Assistant Teachers with Associates degree with appropriate screenings and clearances
- Secure, locked facility
- Financial Assistance available
- Child Care Works (CCW) subsidy through the Early Learning Resource Center (ELRC) accepted.

Pennsylvania Pre-K Counts is a grant-funded program that provides high-quality, pre-kindergarten services to at-risk three- and four-year olds at no cost to families. Children living in families earning up to 300% of poverty, or a family of four earning \$78,600 annually, are eligible to apply.

- Children must turn age three prior to September 1 of the academic school year
- The program is only in session August-June, with select holidays off.
- Families must complete an application and submit documentation of need to be accepted to the program.
- Limited spacing is available.
